1. Introduction

This Notice to Mariners is to raise awareness that the Construction Buoyage within the Moray Offshore Windfarm (West) Limited (Moray West) site is still pending removal from site. Works are now anticipated to take place in October/ November 2025. This Notice to Mariners supersedes the previous versions which anticipated removal of the buoyage by the end of October 2025. The Construction Buoyage currently remains in place, with this document highlighting the new removal dates. Works are planned to commence on 23 October 2025, but due to uncertainties with the weather this may extend into November.

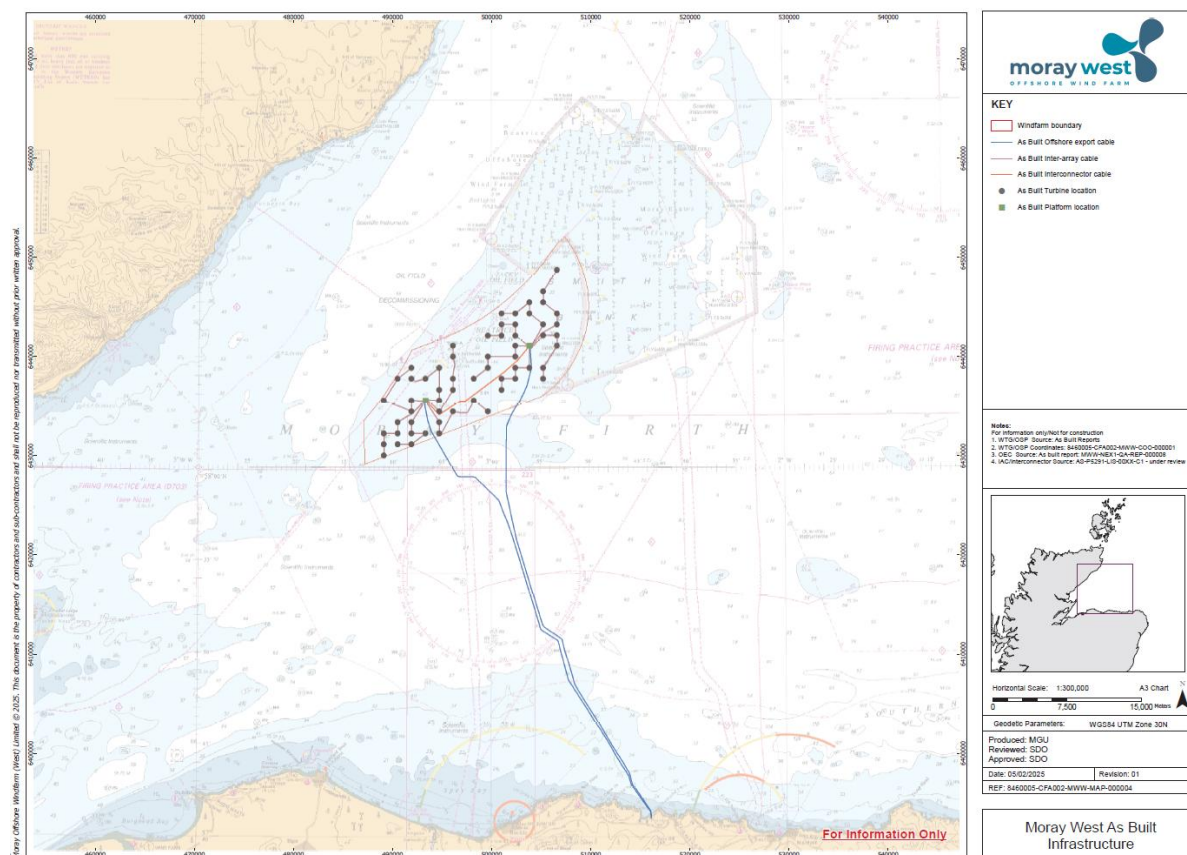


Figure 1. Moray West Wind Farm Site.

The Moray West site is located on the Smith Bank in the Outer Moray Firth, approximately 22.5km from the Caithness coastline. The offshore wind farm site covers an area of approximately 225km². The offshore wind farm site is given in Figure 1.

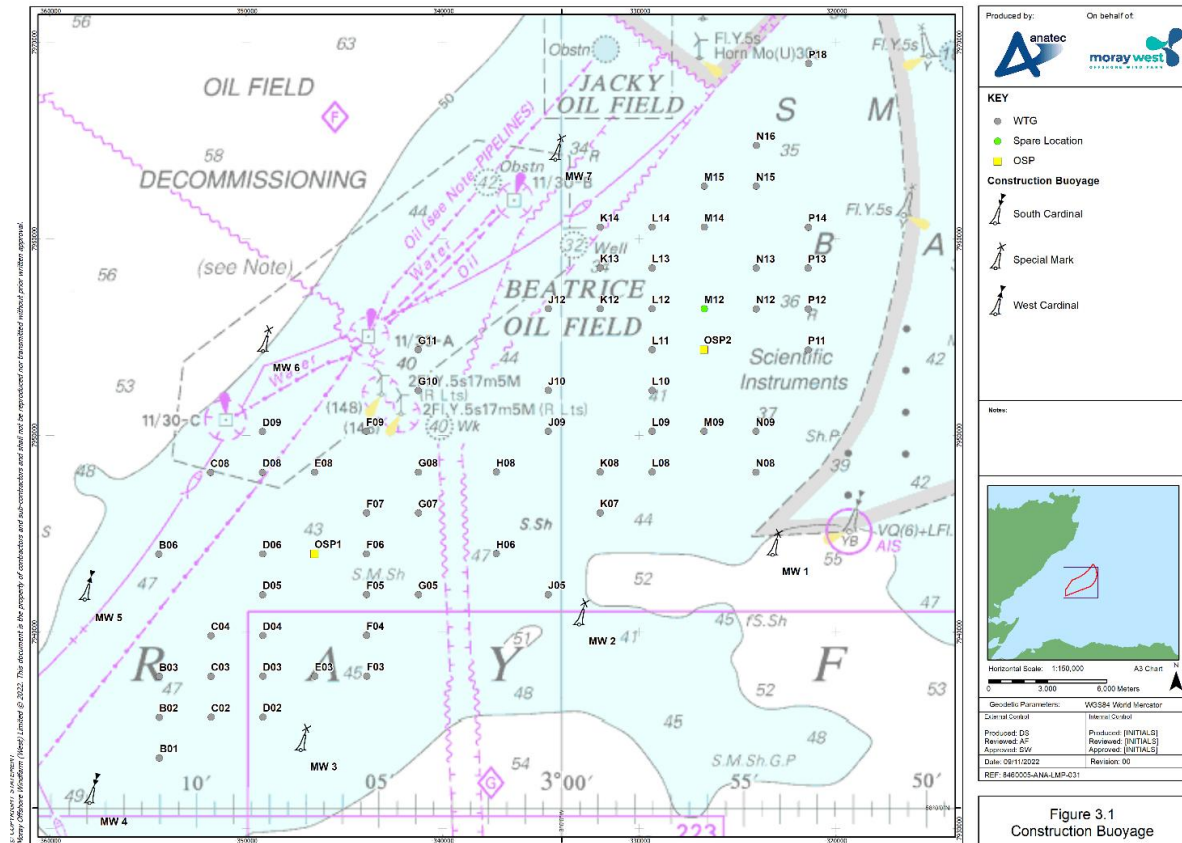


Figure 2. Construction Buoyage

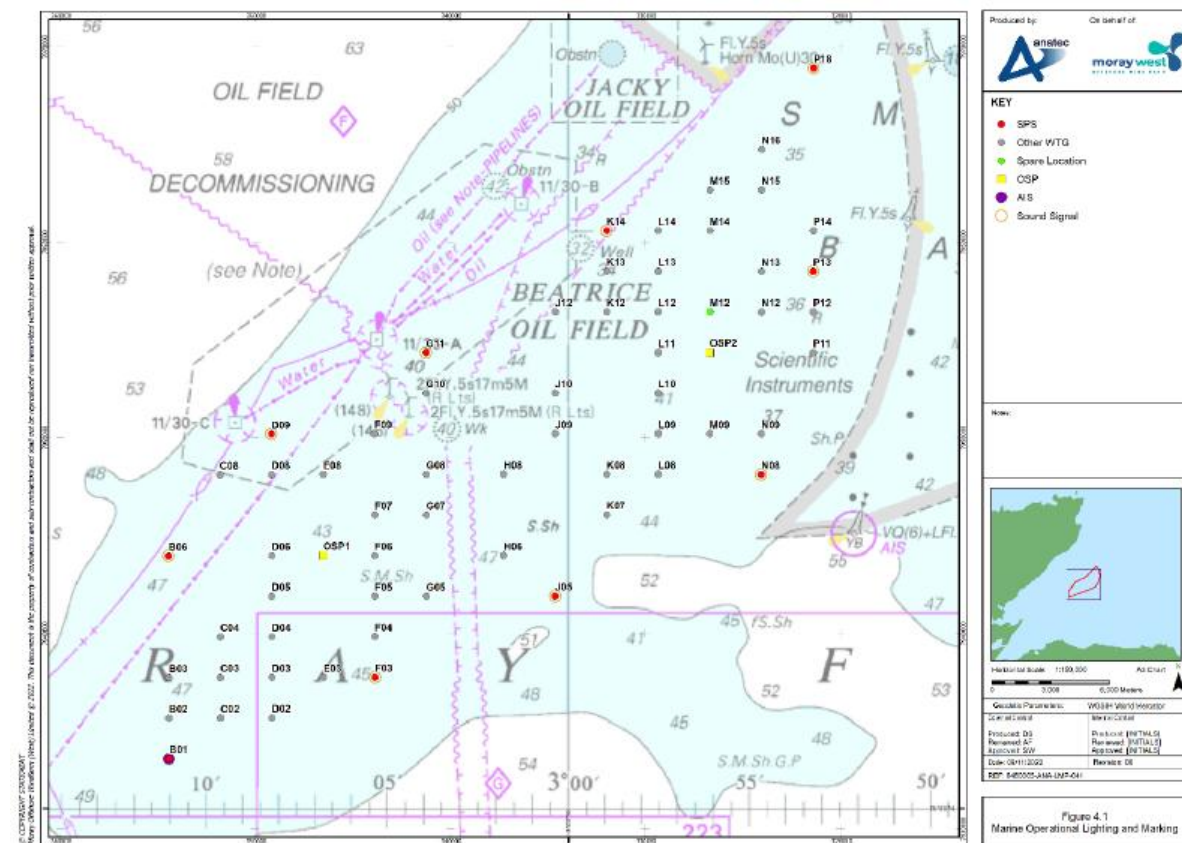


Figure 3. Operational Lighting and Marking

The site is now under operational control, and Moray West is looking to remove construction lighting and buoyage from the area (Figure 2). All operational lighting has been installed and functional as per the Moray West Lighting and Marking Plan (Figure 3) and has been approved by NLB following a site inspection.
